shared a sense of accomplishment after the defense, and also nurtured long lasting friendship.

SpiceWorx believes that these young professionals from Japan and the Philippines will be the future leaders who drive global IT business with Japan-Philippine collaboration. For the fifth implementation of this program in Feb. 2012, about 10 to 15 Japanese nationals and 3 to 4 Filipino nationals will be accepted to participate. Filipino participants will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.
